Pastor: The gift of forgiveness is given to us all by our loving God. **AMEN**




Prayer of the Day (Dawn Lewis)


Romans 5:1-5(CEV)



We do remember.


We remember his life of love, his friendship, his teaching, his dying, and his rising to life again.




