

King of Glory Lutheran Church
Columbarium Committee Minutes
Sunday, February 1, 2026

The meeting was called to order by Jim Cambron and opened with a devotion from Lynda Cambron.

Those members of the committee in attendance were Gabrielle Applequist, Jim Cambron, Lynda Cambron, Brent Thompson, Marilyn Faulk and Patty Larson. Committee Manager Jim Stumpf was also in attendance as was Jim Mossholder who is going off the committee.

The minutes from the meeting of November 2, 2025 were unanimously approved having had a motion to accept the minutes as written by Marilyn Faulk and a second from Brent Thompson.

Jim Cambron discussed the notes from the last three months with Jeanette Berger and Gordon Swenson being the last two to be inurned.

The upkeep schedule is designated as follows: February – Brent Thompson
March – Patty Larson
April – Gabrielle Applequist
May – Brent Thompson

An explanation of Columbarium upkeep was provided to the new members.

Jim Stumpf shared the financial report where we have \$6526.98 in the checking account. It was recommended to renew the CD's of \$30,000 for another year at Mountain West Bank. Our Brick Sale brought in \$150 from the two bricks purchased by Carolyn Jean Smith and Doneta Stephensen. A motion to accept the financial report as given was moved by Brent Thompson and seconded by Lynda Cambron. The motion was unanimously approved.

Jim Stumpf explained that since 2019 the Columbarium Committee has contributed an annual amount of \$175 to the church to cover utility expenses. Considering inflation it was suggested to raise the amount to \$200. Patty Larson moved to raise the amount to \$200 per year. Brent Thompson seconded the motion. During discussion Brent asked questions as to the committee's revenue sources which were addressed by Jim Stumpf. The motion was unanimously approved.

Jim Stumpf presented a packet to the new members describing the roles of committee members. He focused on the role of the Manager providing continuity of the finances, availability of niches and the committee members helping people understand the workings of the Columbarium. Jim also encouraged each member to look with a critical eye for any improvements to be made to the Columbarium.

Jim Stumpf also discussed that the By-Laws haven't been updated since 2019. He volunteered to update and organize the By-Laws and will present, at least an initial draft, at our next meeting.

We will decorate for Easter April 1 at 11:00.

A motion to adjourn was made by Brent Thompson and seconded by Gabrielle Applequist. The motion was unanimously approved. Our next meeting will be Sunday, May 3, 2026
