#### **Community Garden Update Spring 2024**

Well, as the saying goes "Better never means better for everyone". Sadly, we have lost some space (the greenhouse, part of three gardens, the manure pile, finished compost pile and working compost piles) to the land sale, and our resident killdeer have moved to greener pastures. However, I am grateful for being on the KoG taskforce for this whole shindig, as it has allowed me to speak for the people who can't speak for themselves concerning the garden.

I am trying to figure out how to dispose of our green waste. Dumpster pricing is in the hundreds of dollars per week, and if you have noticed how our gardens function, there are several crops going in a year, with unpredictable harvest times. For now, we will probably dispose of ongoing waste in the church dumpster (not ideal due to its relative height compared to our gardeners statures) and then rent something within our budget at the end of the season. So if you see a gardener trying to hoist debris over their heads into the dumpster, an offer of help would be greatly appreciated!

Late March and early April will find me cutting, moving and reinstalling the north section of irrigation pipe, laying "new" used carpet in the pathways, filling the water tanks, and generally getting ready for the gardening season. Yay!!! It should be a wonderful year for gardening. Of course, I say that every year, but it has held true so far!


#### **CHRISTIAN LIFE STUDY GROUP SPRING 2024 READ!**




