

#### **Volunteer Opportunity**

On behalf of the 'Quilt Shippers Organization', I would like to tell you about this group of volunteers who ship your quilts/kits to Portland to the Lutheran World Relief site there. It is a 501-c non-profit organization centered in the Boise area for the purpose of helping churches with the transportation of quilts and other donations to LWR. LWR formed approximately around 2007 as an official organization. There main goal is to help churches around the Treasure Valley in shipping their kits/quilts to LWR. With the cost of shipping it makes it easier for one organization to rent the truck, find drivers, and load it from a central location. Along the drive to Portland, the drivers pick up from several churches along the way to help them defray the shipping costs.

LWR have had a few good leaders in the past and are now looking for help in revitalizing this organization. We are in dire need of a Treasurer and a Secretary to take over the responsibilities of these positions. Our former treasurer and secretary have resigned their positions which they have held for over 5 years. We can always use new people on the board, too. We only meet about once a year. The Treasurer collects the donations that are sent in once a year for shipping and pays the bills that are needed to be paid which is minimal. The secretary keeps the minutes of the meeting, keeps an updated roster of churches that we get kits/quilts from to ship. In the fall, she/he is the one that contacts all the churches that are shipping quilts/kits.

Would you prayerfully think about helping this organization out? We certainly could use your help!






